Tasting

Ruby red colour with purple shades. On the nose the wine is fresh and fruity with notes of spices. Structured palate, melting tannins. Lingered finish on the fruit. Potential of wine aging: 3-5 years.

Terroir

Soil: granitic
Exposition: south - west
Altitude: 230 m
Slope: 5%

Viticulture

Grape variety: Gamay
Plantation density: 10000 plants/ha
Average yield: 45hl/ha
Harvesting by hand

Vinification

Sorting of the harvest on a vibrating table, then on a manual table. Whole bunch vatting. Vinification in open wooden vats with one or two pumpings over per day. Vatting time of 10 to 12 days. After pressing, the wine is put into barrels where the malolactic fermentation will follow. Racking, then light filtration before bottling after 12 months of ageing. No gluing.
